'ORI TAHITI NUI COMPETITION

Created in 2012 by Tumata ROBINSON and Manouche LEHARTEL, **'ORI TAHITI NUI COMPETITIONS** is a Tahitian dance / 'Ori Tahiti contest open to dancers of all nationalities, presenting individually or on behalf of companies and Tahitian dance schools, both local and external to French Polynesia.



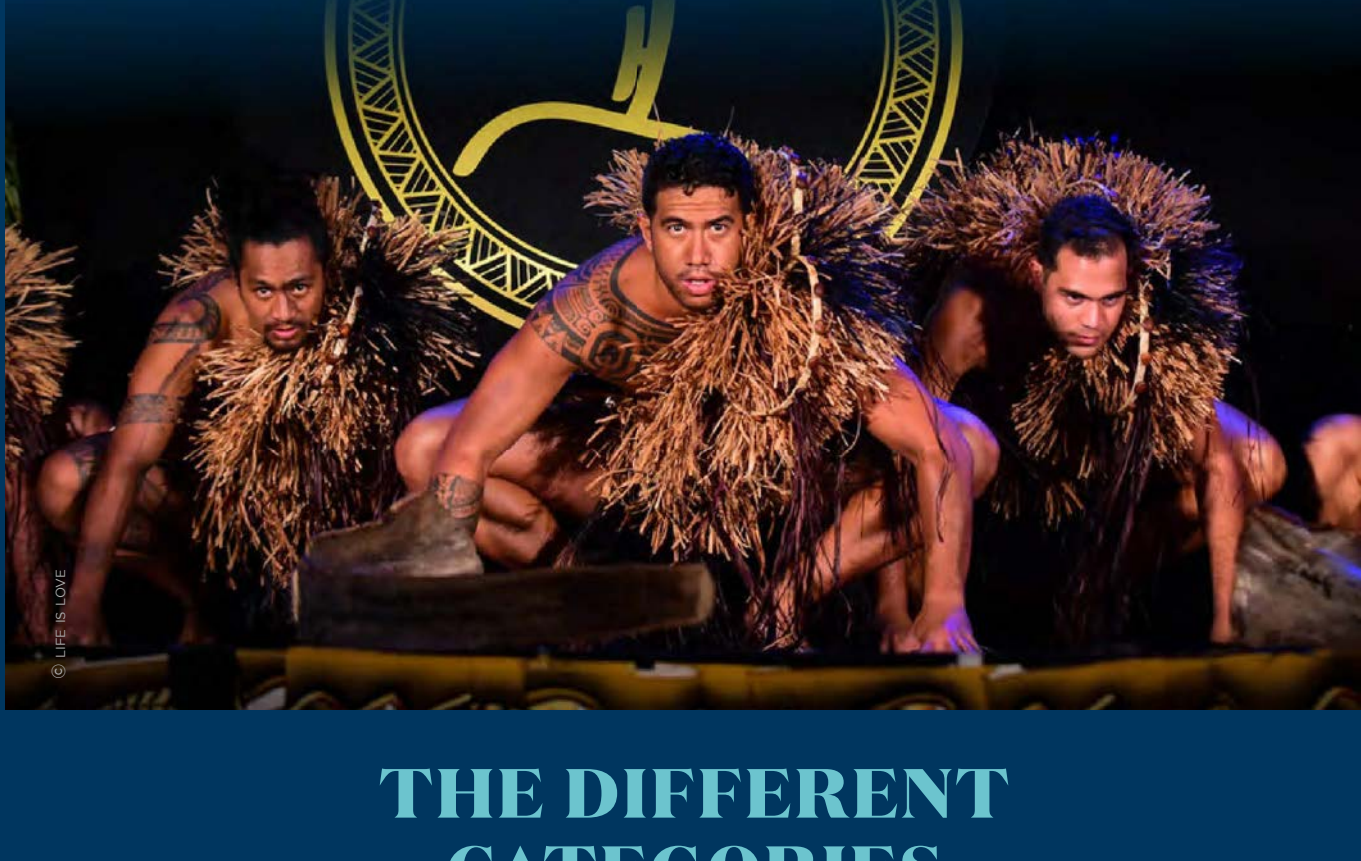
'ORI TAHITI NUI COMPETITIONS

'ORI TAHITI NUI aims to encourage the preservation, development, promotion, and recognition of Polynesian culture in all its forms, especially dance, music, and art craftsmanship, both in Polynesia and around the world.



THE EVENTS INCLUDES

- an individual competition (MEN/WOMEN/CHILDREN)
- a **Mehura** (slow 'aparima) competition by groups of five people (MEN/WOMEN/MIXED)
- an **'Ote'a** competition by groups of five people (MEN/WOMEN/MIXED)
- the **World Championship** of 'ori tahiti.



THE DIFFERENT CATEGORIES

SOLO

Performed to percussion music lasting 1min30 for the Youth and 2min for Adults.

- **YOUTH CATEGORIES OR TAMA** (competition on Saturday morning): Hine Tamahou & Tamahou/Tamahine & Tamaroa/Hine Taure'a & Tama Taure'a
- **ADULT CATEGORIES OR 'ARIOI** (competition on Sunday morning): Toa/'Aito/Hiva/'Feti'a

MEHURA (Competition on Saturday afternoon):

Two categories are open to groups consisting of 5 artists (vahine, tane or mixed) aged 15 and older:

- **AMATEUR CATEGORY**
Groups of 5 performers (primarily made up of artists who have never placed on a podium at an 'Ori Tahiti competition or who are not considered professionals) perform a slow song lasting 3 to 4 minutes
- **PROFESSIONAL CATEGORY**
Groups of 5 artists perform a slow song lasting 3 to 4 minutes

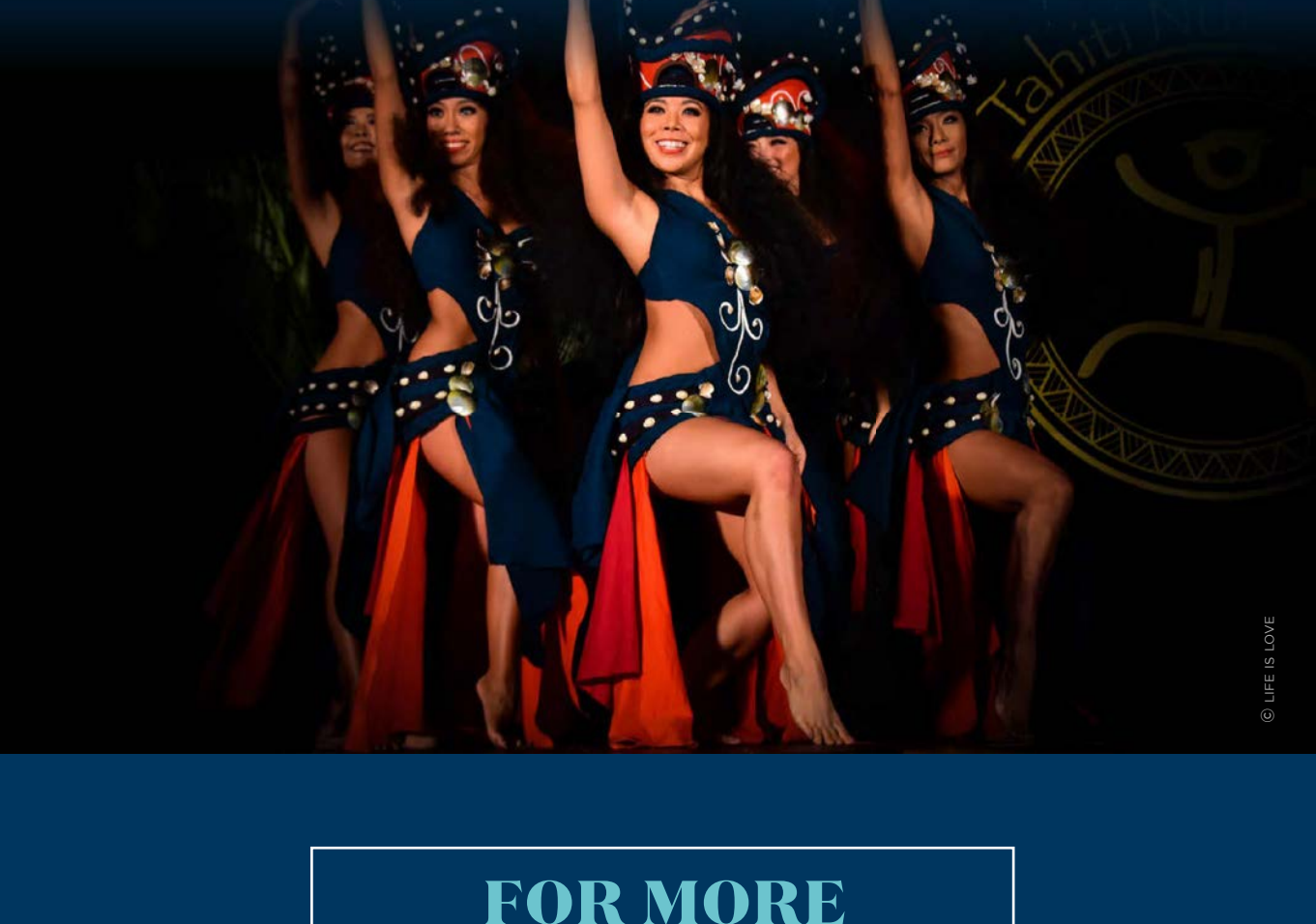
'OTE'A (Competition on Saturday afternoon):

Two categories are open to groups made up of 5 performers (vahine, tane or mixed) who are at least 15 years old:

- **AMATEUR CATEGORY**
Groups of 5 performers (primarily comprised of artists who have never placed on a podium at an 'Ori Tahiti competition or are not deemed professionals) dance to percussion sequences lasting 3 to 4 minutes
- **PROFESSIONAL CATEGORY**
Groups of 5 performers dance to percussion sequences lasting 3 to 4 minutes
